Kit Revision

This is an initial revision of the CY8CKIT-019 PSoC Shield Adapter, Revision **.

Limitations and Known Issues

- When CY8CKIT-031 Linear Slider Module (LSM) is used with the CY8CKIT-019 and CY8CKIT-042 kits, the P1[7] pin on the CY8CKIT-042 will be connected to the BTN3 CapSense sensor on the Linear Slider Module included in the CY8CKIT-031 kit. Pin P1[7] is connected to a 1.0 uF SAR Bypass capacitor (C10) on the CY8CKIT-042. If users wish to enable the CapSense Sensor BTN3 on the Linear Slider Module (LSM) on the CY8CKIT-031 they will need to de-solder the C10 capacitor on the CY8CKIT-042 or the capacitor will saturate the BTN3 CapSense sensor. After removing the C10 capacitor the PSoC 4's ADC will still be functional, but the accuracy of the ADC will be reduced.
